Race Day and Practice Safety

All competitors are expected to follow these safety guidelines as a condition of participation

- All equipment must be in a safe condition.
- All kayaks must be equipped with flotation so that they will float on surface if fully capsized.
- All paddlers must wear a PFD, helmet and appropriate gear to protect against hypothermia.
- All paddlers will paddle in minimum group size of three at all times during training and the competition.
- All participants will follow directions provided by race organizers regarding off-limits areas, areas to put in and take out etc.

Cost for each event is \$20 or \$30 for both together.  
Participants must be covered by CKBC insurance. Either by being a member of a CKBC Club, or paying an additional fee for Day-of-Event Insurance (\$5 for youth and \$10 for Adults)
