On the class 2+ Cedar River near Maple Valley, WA

SATURDAY (Nov 2)

is practice and play time all day. Come practice your river running skills or hone your slalom race skills. Get ready for spring Boating Season!

The Race course (about 22 gates) will likely be set by Friday. The gates may even be pretty close to what it will be on race day earlier in the week, so practice all you want!

Lots of slalom clinic opportunities – check the WKC website. Spots going fast

NOTE: You do NOT need to register for the WKC slalom practice "event" on Nov 2 if you register for the Nov 3 race event, but no problem if you already have. New this year - any racer 17 years old OR YOUNGER, will race for free!

SUNDAY (Nov 3)

Racer's meeting at 10:00 - you must attend! That's when you get your bib and find out when you race.

Set your own goals: try for fast clean runs, or just complete the course!

HOW WILL THIS EVENT BE STRUCTURED? Racer's will be divided into 2 groups. One group will race 11-12:30 (ish) and one will race 1:30-3:00 (ish). Each racer gets 2 timed runs. Only your best one counts! So, you will either race in the morning or the afternoon -- you may be asked to volunteer when you're not

racing: to judge or time. Race Order will be decided the day of. Once all the results are posted, we will give out prizes! They are especially good this year -- don't miss out. Oh yes, there will also be chocolate chip cookies. Can't break tradition.....
