Cost: On-water participation – Saturday only or both Saturday and Sunday: \$20.00 per person online by June 6, 2025. \$30.00 per person after June 8th. 18 years old and younger participate for free. Downriver participation is no extra cost.

If you wish to race more than one slalom class on Sunday, it is an additional \$5.00 per class. Limit of 2 slalom classes per person. There will be separate classes based on age, gender, and type of boat. The prizes (there are many winners at SLS ©) will be Collector's Items! Plan to stay for Awards Ceremony and not miss out.

How to Get There: Navigate I-90 east of Seattle and exit at Roslyn. Drive through town (the whole place is a speed trap and stays a speed trap until you get to the campground: Beware!) to the end of the road, and there you are at both the race site and campground.
